In wealthy Westport, Connecticut, Karstan learns that his mother is a partner in a law firm which represents the companies and organizations who put profit before health, and it "TM's up him to expose classified information about the corrupt American school lunch program. Graciela, a first generation Hispanic-American in California who has diabetes-like symptoms, bravely leads a massive cyberspace march. Lamar, the group geek from Detroit, uses his technological know-how to leak the classified information to 8th Day. They combine their talents toward a nationwide boycott, quickly transforming themselves into trained "agents" on a mission to save the country from its own bad eating habits, with the guidance of their 8th Day mentors. As 8th Day gains ground in revealing the selfishness of the food industry, they are met with increasing resistance from their powerful adversaries. Can the kids overcome junk food foes who are more interested in lining their pockets than promoting health?
